

Kimberly C. David is the Senior Vice President and Chief Business Officer at Baylor College of Medicine (BCM) in Houston, Texas. BCM is recognized as a premier academic health science center known for excellence in education, research and patient care. Located in the Texas Medical Center, BCM has affiliations with eight teaching hospitals, each known for medical excellence.

For 2019-2020, BCM ranked as one of the top 25 medical schools in both the research and primary care medical school rankings published by *U.S. News & World Report*, securing its position as the No. 1 medical school in Texas and the Southwest and one of the top schools in the nation. The College received total annual research and education support of approximately \$502 million and \$507 million in fiscal years ending June 30, 2019 and 2018 respectively, and has more than 90 research and patient-care centers and units.

BCM trains more than 3,600 medical, graduate, nurse anesthesia, physician assistant, and orthotics & prosthetics students, as well as residents and post-doctoral fellows. The College provides extensive patient care services through the Baylor Clinic, located at the western edge of the main campus of Texas Medical Center and on the McNair Campus, as well as faculty physician services provided at independently owned and operated hospitals. These affiliated hospitals serve approximately 126,000 inpatients and 4.4 million outpatients annually.

Before joining BCM in 1998, Kim was a Senior Manager at Andersen (formerly Arthur Andersen) where she worked for ten years. Her tenure at Andersen included six years as an Auditor for various companies, two years as a Business Consultant and two years as a Manager of Operations for a division of one of the firm's consulting practices.

Since joining BCM, Kim has served as the Assistant Vice President of Finance and Vice President of Finance. In 2008, she became the Vice President and Chief Financial Officer of the College, and in 2012 became the Senior Vice President and Chief Financial Officer. In 2014, Kim was promoted to her new role as Senior Vice President and Chief Business Officer.

Kim earned her Bachelors of Science in Accounting from Oklahoma State University and her Master of Business Administration from Rice University. Kim is also a Certified Public Accountant. Kim currently serves on the boards of Child Advocates, DePelchin Children's Center, The Immunization Partnership, and the Jones Partners at Rice University. Most recently Kim was recognized with the 2019 Award for Women in Banking & Finance by the Women's Resource of Houston.
